Methodology

The May 30th results are based on the CPAC-SES nightly tracking. It includes 1,000 interviews completed between May 26th and May 30th, 2004.

The June 6th results are based on the CPAC-SES nightly tracking. It includes 1,000 interviews completed between June 2nd and June 6th.

The margin of accuracy for each gender is identified at the bottom of each gender column.

The sample is representative of the Canadian electorate both geographically and demographically. Readers should also note that percentages may not add up to 100 due to rounding. Both polls were registered with the Canadian Survey Research Council of which SES is a member.
