

2nd Choice/Swing Voter Analysis


$^{\text{1}}$ 2nd Choice of Committed Liberal Voters (N= 514, MoE \pm 4.4%)

Swing Voters

9% of Canadians would consider voting for the Liberals, Conservatives or NDP.

Among undecided voters, 20% would consider voting Liberal, 19% would consider voting CP, and 17% would consider voting NDP.
