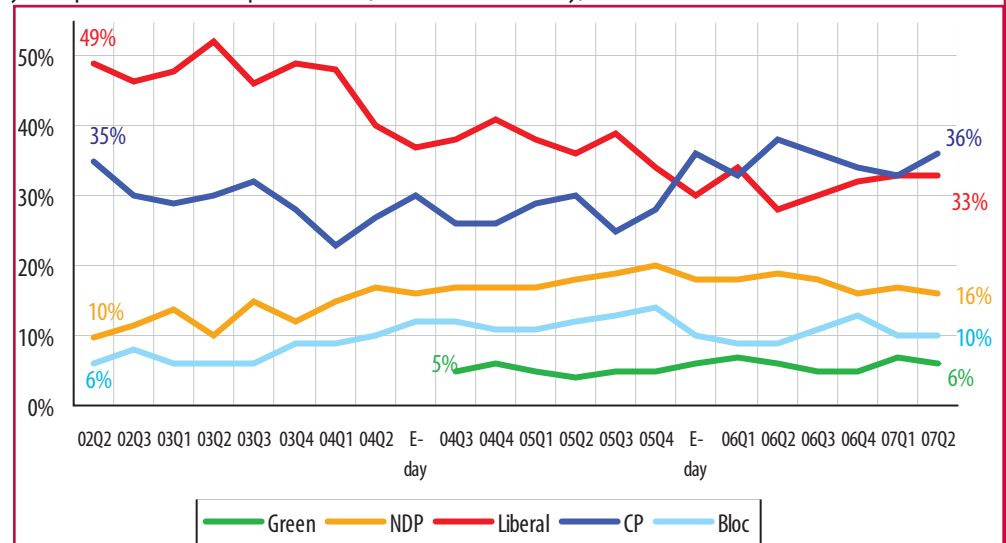
# Federal Grits Drop in Quebec – Tories Still Short of Majority

## SES Research Poll

To follow is a review of SES' latest national random telephone survey of Canadians 18 and over completed between March 31st and April 5th, 2007. The statistics of committed voters for the current wave is accurate to within 3.2 percentage points, plus or minus, 19 times out of 20. The margin of accuracy will be wider for sub samples. Percentages may exceed 100 due to rounding.

The research was registered with the Marketing Research and Intelligence Association of which SES is a Gold Seal Corporate member.
