



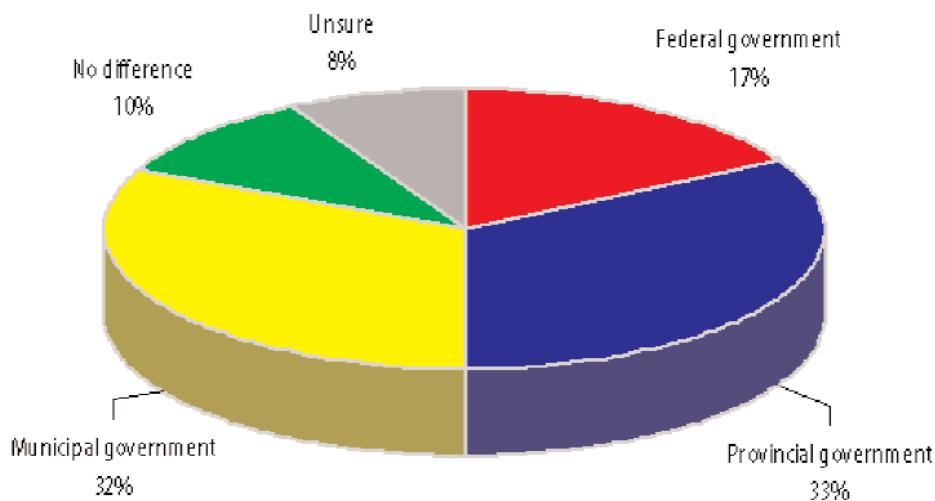

Spending Canadians' Tax Dollars

SES National Omnibus March 2005

To follow is a review of SES' latest national telephone survey of 2,000 Canadians completed between March 17 to 22, 2005. The survey is accurate to within 2.2 percentage points, plus or minus, 19 times out of 20. The margin of accuracy will be wider for sub samples. Percentages may exceed 100 due to rounding. The research was registered with the Market Research and Intelligence Association
