Fans hope for Stanley Cup as Leafs start new season

Toronto - The leaves are changing, the baseball playoffs are underway, and the long Thanksgiving weekend is almost here.

The Leafs kick-off the 2006-2007 season tonight with their home opener against the Ottawa Senators.
