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The weekend of any campaign sees the release of a number of polls. During the last election, CPAC-SES tracking polls were often in the news. Here is the first of this election campaign, delivered by SES pollster Nikita Nanos.

It is a random telephone survey of 1,200 Canadians that took place from Nov. 29 to Dec. 1.

The poll is considered accurate, plus or minus 2.9 per cent, 19 times out of 20.
