Voters craving shakeup: Poll

The appetite for change at Queen's Park is growing ravenous, a new media poll suggests. An SES Research poll found 52% of Ontario voters think it's time to change the government while 32% are satisfied with the status quo.

The same poll showed that the Liberals have the support of 53% of decided voters, compared to 32% who favour the Tories and 15% who support the NDP.

The poll also found that Premier Ernie Eves trails Liberal Leader Dalton McGuinty as the people's choice for best premier, 34% to 36%.

Eves said yesterday the only poll he's interested in is the one on election day.

The poll of 500 provincial voters conducted May 26-27 is considered accurate within 4.5 percentage points 19 times out of 20.
