CPAC/SES POLL ON VOTER SATISFACTION

(OTTAWA, April 26, 2004)—Nikita Nanos, President of SES Canada Research, joins Martin Stringer tonight on *PrimeTime Politics* to preview a SES/CPAC poll to be released tomorrow.

According to SES, the poll results indicate that 50% of Canadians think it is time for a change of government, while only 28% thought the Martin led liberals deserved to be re-elected.
